The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to sanction the setting up of a Government Sponsored Degree College named "Bhairab Ganguly College" at Belghoria with effect from the current academic session viz. 1968-69.

2) The College will be affiliated, for the present, in Pre-University Arts Course in English, Bangali, History, Logic, Civics, Mathematics and Sanskrit and in Three Year Degree Arts Course, in English, Bengali, History, Philosophy, Economics, Political Science, Mathematics and Sanskrit.

3) During the current year the number of students in the college will be, approximately, as follows:-
Pre-University Arts Class- 100
1st Year Degree Arts Cours- 100

4) Tuition fees will be charged at the following rates:-
Pre-University Arts @ Rs. 8/- P.m.
Three Year Degree Arts (Pass) @ Rs. 10/- p.m.

5) In addition, a development fee of Rs.1/- per month will be realised from each student. Free studentships and Half-Free studentships will be awarded to the students according to existing rules.

6) Sanction of the Governor is now accorded to the payment of a capital grant of Rs. 36,000/- (Rupees thirty six thousand) only, as detailed in the margin, during current Financial year for this purpose 50% of the grant should be released immediately and the balance in due course on the basis of utilisation of the grant, already released.

1) Furniture-Rs- 20,000/-	
2) Equipment (Fans etc.) -Rs. 6,000/-	
3) Books -Rs 10,000/-	

Total : Rs. 36,000/-	

7) Sanction of the Governor is also accorded to the payment, during the current financial year of a further grant of Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand) to the College toward its maintenance during 1968-69.

8) The College should maintain the teaching, non-teaching and inferior staff as laid down in the annexed statement subject to the condition that actual recruitment should be made on the basis of actual requirements of the College and with the approval of the Director of Public Instruction, West Bengal.

9) The charge will be not from the provision under the head "M. Development Schemes-Fourth Five Year Plan-University and Collegiate Education-Development of ~~non-~~ non- Government Colleges-Grants-in-aid, Contribution etc." In the current year's 28-Education Budget.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Government Order No. 1404-Edn(CS), dated the 24th July, 1967 regarding the closing of the Arts Section of the Vivekananda Centenary College, Rahara, and to say that in accordance with the arrangements made in Government Order No. 1457-Edn(CS), dated the 12th August, 1968, a few surplus staff of the Arts Section of that College have already been placed at the disposal of the authorities of the Bhairab Ganguly College on loan basis till their absorption at the latter college under terms and conditions laid down in the above mentioned Government Order.


