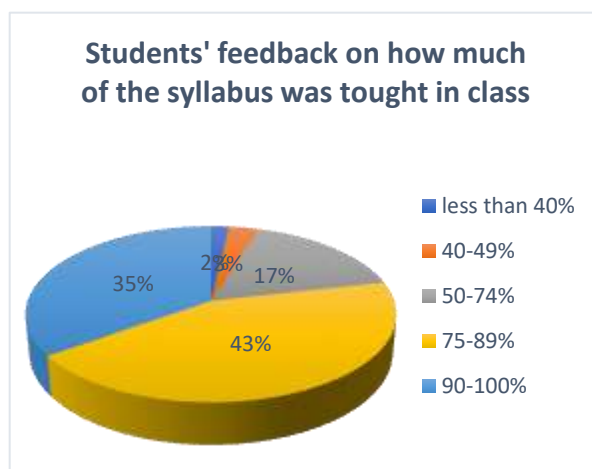
Institution obtains feedback from the students of all streams on various aspects like infrastructural facilities, course content etc. using Google form.

Sample size: Total 666 UG students gave their feedback on various aspects on their curriculum through Google form for the academic session 2019-20.

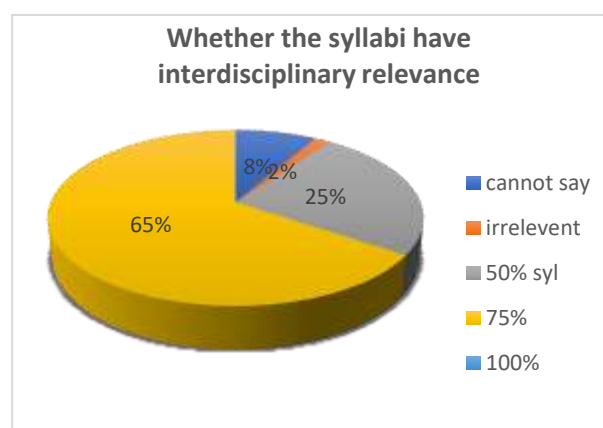
Question: How much of the Syllabus was taught in class?

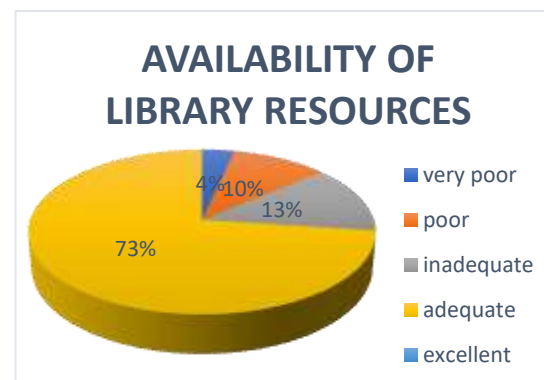

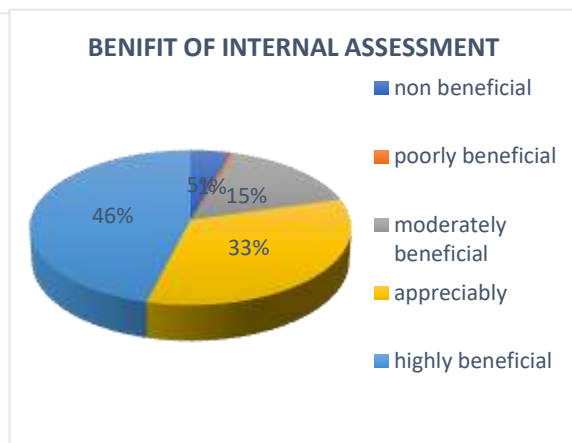

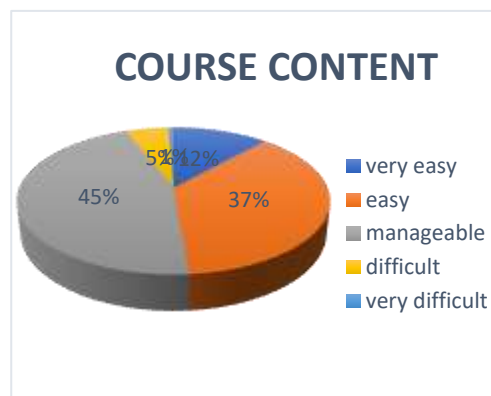

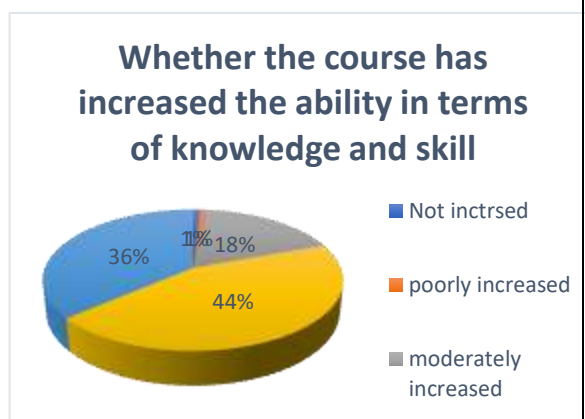

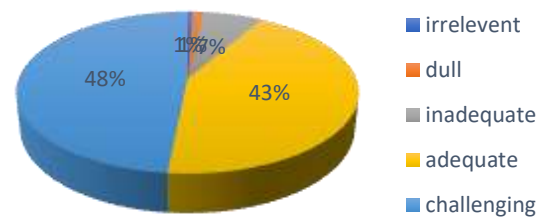

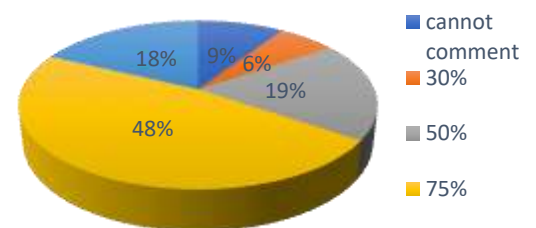

Question: How much of your course content do you find relevant to the current job market?

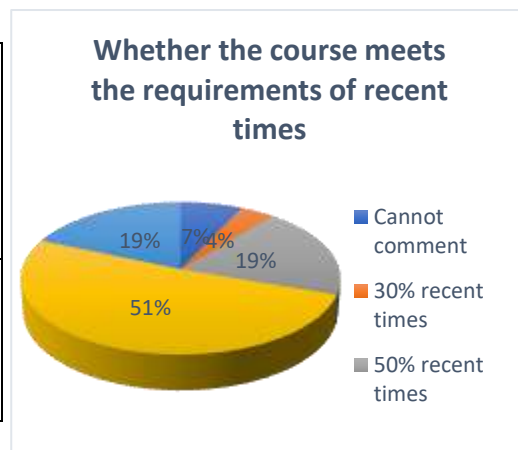
