If we look at various definitions of Myth, there is one common characteristic. That is, Myth is a symbolic narrative mainly of gods and goddess or virtuous man and woman, which most of the times, convey a moral.

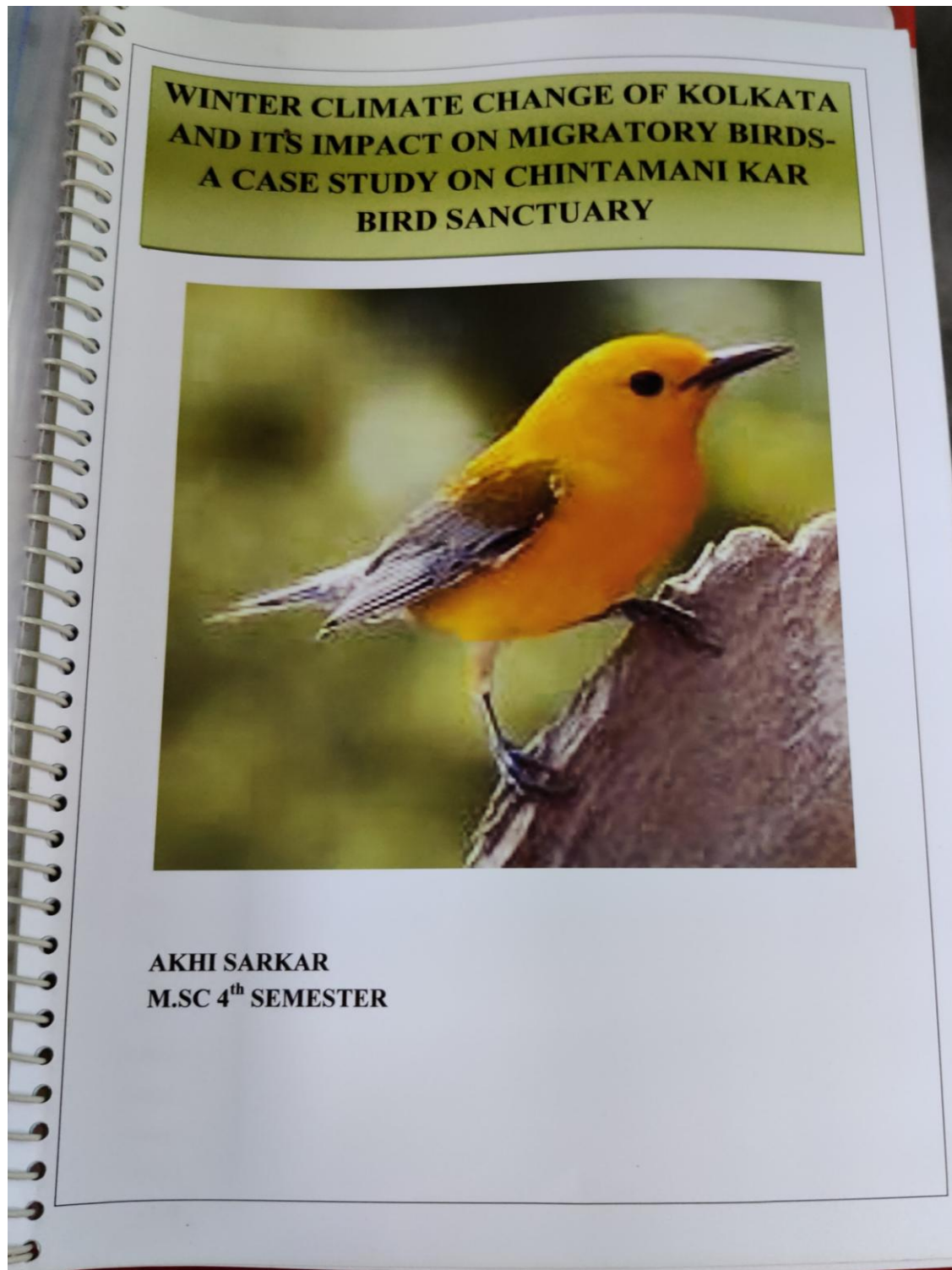

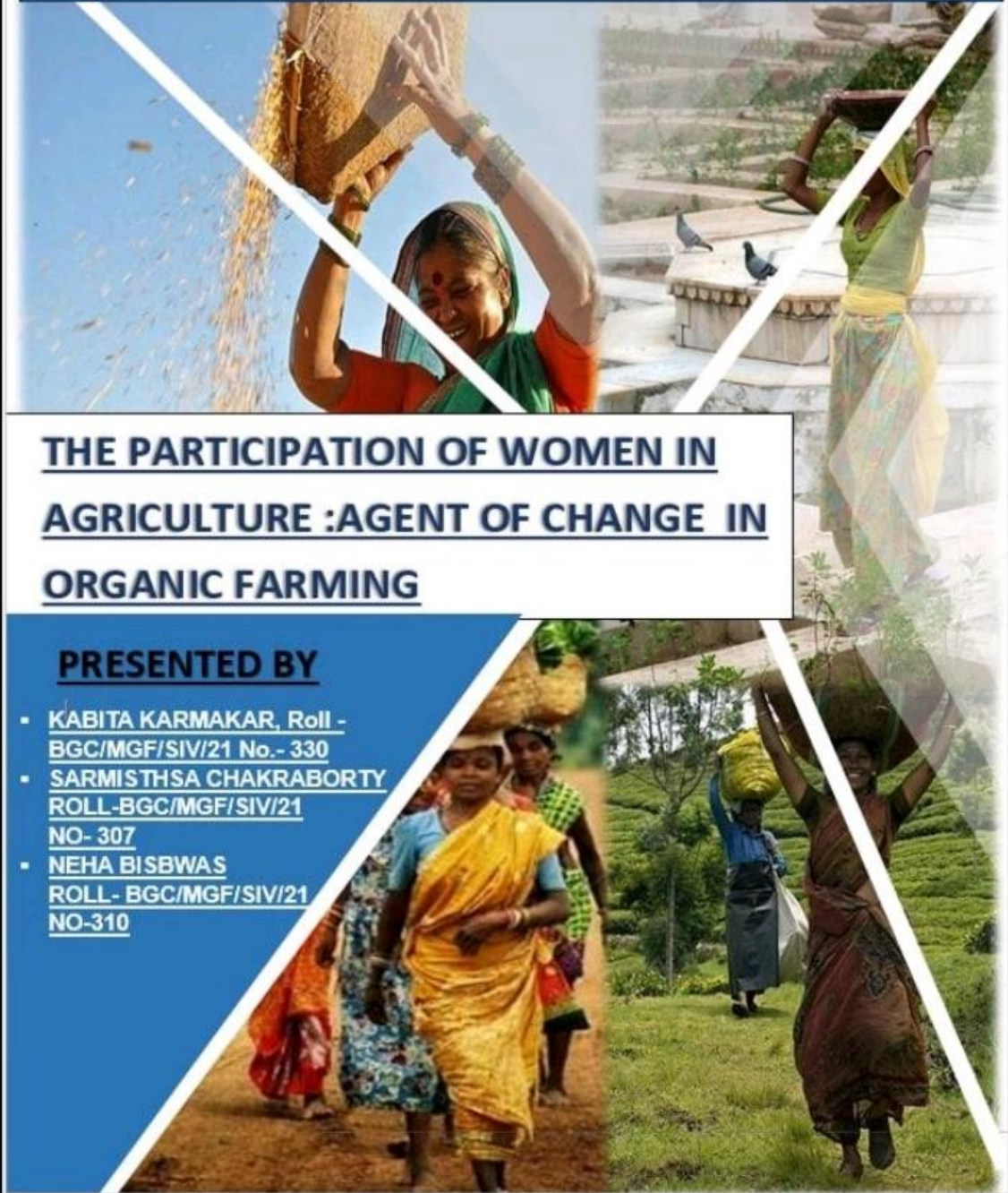
