Bhairab Ganguly College is an esteemed academic institution situated at the northern fringe of Kolkata metropolis of West Bengal. The college is located at the core of Kamarhati Municipal area with Barrackpore Trunk Road in the west and railway line in the east. The college was established on 3rd September 1968, under the initiative of late Jibandhan Ganguly, a renowned philanthropist of Belgharia. The Degree College was named after the late grandfather of Jibandhan Ganguly as Bhairab Ganguly College. The Arts section of Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Centenary College was merged with this newly established College and consequently a host of experienced teachers joined this institution both enriching and enhancing the faculty pool of the College. It became a Government sponsored college and was recognized under section 2(f) and 12 (f) of the UGC Act. In 2016, the NAAC recognized Bhairab Ganguly College as an 'A' Grade (CGPA of 3.01) institution, thus acknowledging its persistent enterprise to form better members for a better society. The College at present has total student strength of approximately five thousand and is imparting learning in diverse areas of Humanities, Commerce and Basic Sciences. There are Honors courses in 21 disciplines, 3 general programs and 4 PG programs. Its unique infrastructure is indeed commendable as the College has maintained an idyllic campus adorned with greenery, flower gardens, football ground, a colossal Indoor Sports Complex (Toruner Swapna), an Auditorium equipped with the state-of-the-art acoustics system (Alapan), Meteorological Observatory, a History Museum (Heritage), Open Air Theatre (Mukto Mon), Medicinal Garden (Niramoy Nikunja), Rain Water Harvesting Scheme (Megh Kalas), Butterfly garden, a well-equipped College Gymnasium, new College Canteen, Girls' and Boys' Common Room etc. Sir J.C. Bose Research Unit was setup to facilitate research activities of faculties.



Bhairab Ganguly College is an esteemed academic institution situated at the northern fringe of Kolkata metropolis of West Bengal. The college is located at the core of Kamarhati Municipal area with Barrackpore Trunk Road in the west and railway line in the east. The college was established on 3rd September 1968, under the initiative of late Jibandhan Ganguly, a renowned philanthropist of Belgharia. The Degree College was named after the late grandfather of Jibandhan Ganguly as Bhairab Ganguly College. The Arts section of Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Centenary College was merged with this newly established College and consequently a host of experienced teachers joined this institution both enriching and enhancing the faculty pool of the College. It became a Government sponsored college and was recognized under section 2(f) and 12 (f) of the UGC Act. In 2016, the NAAC recognized Bhairab Ganguly College as an 'A' Grade (CGPA of 3.01) institution, thus acknowledging its persistent enterprise to form better members for a better society. The College at present has total student strength of approximately five thousand and is imparting learning in diverse areas of Humanities, Commerce and Basic Sciences. The college was established on 3rd September 1968, under the initiative of late Jibandhan Ganguly, a renowned philanthropist of Belgharia. The Degree College was named after the late grandfather of Jibandhan Ganguly as Bhairab Ganguly College. The Arts section of Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Centenary College was merged with this newly established College and consequently a host of experienced teachers joined this institution both enriching and enhancing the faculty pool of the College. It became a Government sponsored college and was recognized under section 2(f) and 12 (f) of the UGC Act. tried to educate the poor down troden children with the recurring grant paid by the college authority. In a way we are recruiting 2 teachers paid by our college for educating children despite their financial crisis.





Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) 2020-2021

Our College has adopted the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0 (UBA) program initiated by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, inspired by the vision of transformational change in the processes of rural development by leveraging higher educational institutions to help build an Inclusive India. The Mission of UBA is to enable to work with the people of rural India, identifying region-specific challenges and evolving appropriate and realistic solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. College has resolved to make the following adopted villages self reliant through knowledge and practice: Bagdiha, Chaltha, Kalyam, Makhnu, Ledapakur, Bankura district, West Bengal Perennial Assistance Award was announced on 15th Aug 2020 (in virtual mode) by UBA.78 participating Institutions from India were awarded and our College got the recognition for the same. The template for plan of action and future activities has been reviewed and Rs.1.75 lakhs has been funded by the National Coordinating Institute UBA2.0 (IIT Delhi) to our Institution's account.

Activities during lock-down period

- 1. Masks were distributed among the villagers of the 5 villages and awareness on covid infection was spread involving the Panchayat Mukhia.
- 2. Distribution of 600 kgs of rice and ration in 2 villages (Kulam and Juvi), to support nearly 200 distressed tribal people.
- 3. On 10.09.2021 in two villages named Ledapakur and Chaltha in Bankura district, West Bengal, thirty Solar lanters, six sewing, two dice machines for making sal-leaf plates were distributed.





Alumni Association Acitivity

Alumni Association "Abahaman" was registered under West Bengal Act XXVI of 1961 (S/2L/No 45458, dated 23rd November, 2015). It started with 70 members. Now in 2020-21, the number of members has increased to 307. The main objective of the Association is to foster strong bonds between Alumnae, Faculty and students of the college. It acts as a bridge between the Past and Present of college. Departmental Alumnae gatherings are also conducted. The Alumnus serves as a resource person for seminars and special lectures organised by the Department. Their guidance enhances offer for professional and career development. Bhairab Ganguly College is an esteemed academic institution situated at the northern fringe of Kolkata metropolis of West Bengal. The college is located at the core of Kamarhati Municipal area with Barrackpore Trunk Road in the west and railway line in the east. The college was established on 3rd September 1968, under the initiative of late Jibandhan Ganguly, a renowned philanthropist of Belgharia. The Degree College was named after the late grandfather of Jibandhan Ganguly as Bhairab Ganguly College. The Arts section of Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Centenary College was merged with this newly established College and consequently a host of experienced teachers joined this institution both enriching and enhancing the faculty pool of the College. It became a Government sponsored college and was recognized under section 2(f) and 12 (f) of the UGC Act. In 2016, the NAAC recognized Bhairab Ganguly College as an 'A' Grade (CGPA of 3.01) institution, thus acknowledging its persistent enterprise to form better members for a better society. The College at present has total student strength of approximately five thousand and is imparting learning in diverse areas of Humanities, Commerce and Basic Sciences. Date of implementation: 10.09.21

About the activity: A team of 5 members from the college had conducted a distribution programme at two of the adopted villages, Ledapkaur&Chaltha in the Ranibandh subdivision of Bankura District of West Bengal. The objective behind this action was to illuminate the homes, which are deprived of a basic amenity, that of an electricity connection, in order to facilitate an environment conducive to the study hours necessary for school-going children in the village. The team also focused on the contribution technology can make through the spread of education, pursuing which is an activity which is hindered by the lack of basic amenities and facilities.




