THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made on this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2017, BETWEEN BHAIRAB GANGULY COLLEGE, UGC approved 2nd cycle NAAC accredited grade 'A' college affiliated under the West Bengal State University and Government of West Bengal aided college, having its campus at M.M. Feeder Road, Belgharia, Kolkata-700056, West Bengal, represented by its Principal Dr. MINAKSHI RAY, daughter of LATE SISIR KUMAR SINGH RAY, hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns) OF THE ONE PART

AND

RIGHT BRAINS TECHNOLOGY, a private concern, having its office at Ground Floor, Sanghoti Abasan, Garia Main Road, P.S. Narendrapur, Kolkata-700 084, represented by its Proprietor Sri Rajib Mukherjee, son of Sri Ananda Gopal Mukherjee, hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns) OF THE OTHER PART.

WHEREAS the BHAIRAB GANGULY COLLEGE, with a view to improving Advancement of Learning and Need-based Education desirous to provide carrier-oriented Certificate Course of **Web Design** in collaboration with the Right Brains Technology, a registered software company and the Second Party has agreed to the said proposal.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH and it is agreed by and between both the parties hereto as follows:

1. Those for the above mentioned purpose both the Parties have agreed to start Web Design Course.
2. The Computer Science Department of the First Party will design the content of the course and the placement cell of the college will look after the day-to-day activities.
2. That the Second Party/ Right Brains Technology will render and provide online Web Design Training, Technical advice and assistance to the students who enrol themselves for the said Course.
3. That the Course fee will be Rs.2000/-(Rupees two thousand) only which is to be deposited in the College Account and the duration of the Course will be at least 30 hours.
4. Out of the total Course fee, College will deduct 10% amount for institutional overhead expenditure and 2<sup>nd</sup> Party will be entitled to remaining 90% amount of the Course fee.
5. That after successful completion of the Course the participant student will get Certificate.
6. Both the Parties will take necessary permission/ Approval from the concerned Authorities regarding the above matters.
7. Both the Parties have agreed that if additional assistance is required, Principal of BHAIRAB GANGULY COLLEGE, and Mr. Rajib Mukherjee of Right Brains Technology will settle the matter mutually after discussions.
8. That in respect of the above mentioned Course only the Principal of the college will take all responsibilities regarding selection of candidates/participants and other matters of the said purpose.
9. If any disputes arise in respect of this Agreement, then Principal of the College and Mr. Rajib Mukherjee will discuss and settle the matter amicably.

10. That this Memorandum of Understanding is valid up to 05.11.2022.

11. The College can provide Students only but the college will not take any financial responsibility.

12. That Right Brains Technology will be entitled only to 90% of the Course fee from the College for the Course.
