The NSS activities conducted by our college during [year] witnessed positive outcomes and significant impact in various spheres. Some notable achievements include:


- Increased awareness about health and hygiene practices among community members through consistent educational campaigns.

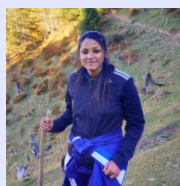

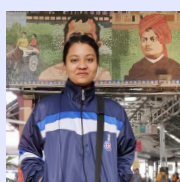
