15.08.17, 23.01.18, 26.01.18	College Campus	Hoisting of National Flag by NSS In-Charge, Dr. Asitendu Roychowdhury and NSS Programme Officer Dr. Saurav Shome. NSS volunteers, office bearers of Students' Union and general students, non-teaching staff members and local children were present. The days were also celebrated by discussion on glorious history of these historical days, recitation and National Song. The number of NSS volunteers participated in the Independence day, Birthday of Netaji and Republic Day celebration were 28, 34 and 37 respectively.
10 th July – 7 th August, 2017	Barasat Zilla Parishad Bhawan	20 NSS volunteers took active roles in managing candidates called for interview at West Bengal Regional school service commission at Barasat Zilla Parishad Bhawan where they provide active support to the office-bearers and the candidates
24.08.17	College Campus & Alapan	24 th September has been observed and celebrated as the NSS Day commemorating the day of establishment of National Service Scheme in 1969. One-day camp was organized in association with IQAC, where a tree plantation ceremony was organized by the NSS unit. College Flag was hoisted by Dr. Minakshi Ray, Principal & Patron-in-Chief, NSS Unit, Bhairab Ganguly College. The NSS Flag was hoisted by Dr. Asitendu Roychowdhury, In-Charge, NSS Unit, Bhairab Ganguly College. 35 saplings of 8 different spp. were planted in the college ground by the NSS volunteers and teaching and non-teaching staff to support sustainable development and to maintain ecological balance. 58 NSS volunteers participated in the One-day camp. A campus cleaning and spraying of bleaching powder drive were carried out. 50 saplings of Arjuna tree were donated to 5 neighboring schools to develop green environment in local areas and create awareness about biodiversity and eco-friendly environment among young minds.

Dr. Saurav Shome, In-charge of the department of Zoology and NSS Programme Officer gave awareness lectures regarding mosquito-borne diseases, Thalassemia and AIDS. Campus cleaning programme and spraying of bleaching powder were also undertaken. 53 NSS volunteers participated in the programme.
